

# ICELAND

September 23-28, 2018

*Iceland is an amazing country filled with beautiful nature, wonderful food, inspiring art and cultures. The capital of Reykjavik is world-renowned for its many accomplishments, history, and natural beauty on all fronts and is truly the gateway to Iceland. We will be staying in the city of Reykjavik every night and taking day trips to the surrounding mountains, glaciers, volcanos and hot springs.*

## **Day 1: Sunday September 23, 2018 - Chicago to Reykjavik**

Fly from Chicago O'Hare to Keflavik, Iceland on your overnight flight.

## **Day 2: Monday September 24, 2018 Arrival - City Sightseeing**

This morning you will be met by your local guide in the arrival hall at Keflavik Airport. Transfer to your hotel in Reykjavik where you will have an early check in and enjoy breakfast. This afternoon enjoy a City Sightseeing tour. During this tour you will see the old town center, Parliament, the Cathedral, the harbor, and much more. This evening enjoy a group dinner at a local restaurant. **(Breakfast, Dinner)**

## **Day 3: Tuesday September 25, 2018 - Golden Circle Tour**

This full-day tour of the southwest of Iceland includes three of the best known attractions Iceland has to offer: Gullfoss (The Golden Waterfall), one of the most impressive waterfalls in Europe with thousands of tons of icy water thundering majestically into a deep canyon; The Geysir Area, with numerous hot springs, fumaroles and geysers, including the 30-meter spouting world known Strokkur and Pingvellir, a remarkable geological site and a historic site as well. Pingvellir is the site of the world's oldest democratic parliament founded in 930 and the beautiful canyon running through the park is actually the dividing fault line between two of the earth's tectonic plates. **(Breakfast, Lunch)**

## **Day 4: Wednesday September 26, 2018 - South Shore Adventure**


Today you will have frequent views of mountains, including snow shrouded Hekla, the country's most active volcano and the towering, ice capped strato volcano Eyjafjallajokull. Continue through the region where one of the best known of the Icelandic classical sagas, Njal's Saga is set. Next, we stop at the spectacular waterfalls of Seljalandsfoss and Skogarfoss to view the water tumbling over high rock escarpments. We will also visit the Skogar Folk Museum preserving the cultural heritage of South Iceland. We continue our travels past Dyrhólaey, a magnificent rocky headland with sheer cliffs that face the beautiful seaside village of Vik, where lunch is included today. After lunch, we head for the sea shore, flanked by steep bird cliffs rising above the black and wave pounded sands. In the sea just outside the village of Vik are Reynisdrangar rocks- 66 meters above sea level at their highest. According to legend the Reynisdrangar were formed when two trolls were trying to drag a three-masted ship to land. When daylight broke they turned into a stone. **(Breakfast, Lunch)**

## **Day 5: Thursday September 27, 2018 - Blue Lagoon & Reykjavik at leisure**

Enjoy an energizing visit to one of Iceland's most famous natural wonders. The Blue Lagoon is a unique experience; a lagoon with pleasantly warm mineral-rich geothermal water in a middle of a black lava field. The high natural levels of silica and minerals give the Lagoon its rich blue color. The facilities include modern changing rooms and showers, an indoor geothermal pool, restaurants and other services. Enjoy the rest of your day in Reykjavik at leisure. Reykjavik is a modern city with a variety of restaurants, museums, galleries and theatre. Enjoy a walk in the old town, city center, where you can explore the Parliament, the Cathedral, shops or the new Harpa Music Hall. **(Breakfast)**

## **Day 6: Friday September 28, 2018 - Airport Transfer / Return Flight Home**

This morning you will have a few more hours of free time before your private coach picks you up for your flight departure and delivers you to Keflavik International Airport. **(Breakfast)**
